Laws 2016, Second Special Session, Chapter 6 Reductions (SB-9)

This memo is intended to provide additional instructions related to the reductions from the Instructional Material Fund and Transportation Distribution under provisions of SB-9 as enacted during the 2016 second special session. In executing the reductions, please use the following instructions:

- 1) Submit a revised "Adjustment Form" to Antonio Ortiz and a copy to Anthony Burns by Friday December 16th (form is attached).
- 2) Submit a reduction Budget Adjustment Request (BAR) reflecting the decrease from the Instructional Material Fund, the Transportation Fund or both funds. For the Instructional Materials reduction, please select revenue code 43207 or 43211 and one or both expenditure codes 56107 and 56111. For the Transportation reduction use revenue code 43206. As supporting documentation, attach a copy of the original memorandum and attachments sent on December 7, 2016 along with the revised "Adjustment Form" and a copy of the check for any reduced amount to the Instructional Materials Fund.
- 3) For the Instructional Materials reduction, please prepare a check for the reduced BAR amount. On the "memo" line of the check please reference "Instructional Materials Fund Reduction (SB-9)". Please submit check to:

4) All reduction BAR's shall be submitted through OBMS no later than December 20, 2016. The only exception to this deadline will be for those school districts and charter schools that had their regular

school board or governance council meetings prior to December 7, 2016. The latest date for these exceptions will be January 13, 2016.
