Academic/Social Athletic Standards

Please complete bottom portion and return to Athletic Director by Athletes first practice.

1. Students must maintain the equivalent of a 2.0 average with no failing grades for academic eligibility. If a student with a 2.0 grade point average receives two D's or one F on a grade check or report card, he/she shall be placed on a two-week probationary period to bring grades up. During this time the athlete may practice with his/her team, but may not participate in games. Once grade point average is actable or after the two-week probationary period, the athlete must submit a new grade check to the Athletic Director for eligibility.
2. It will be the **responsibility of the student-athlete** to give each of his/her teachers a grade check form once every two weeks on the day assigned and return the form to the Athletic Director in a timely manner. Failure to submit grade check within the designated time could result in loss of participation time for Athlete.
3. If a student with a 2.0 grade receives an unsatisfactory mark in conduct for any reason, he/she may be placed on a 1-week probationary period to bring the mark back up.
4. Students must maintain an acceptable level of discipline in the school and on the athletic field.
5. Medical permission (proof of physical) is due the first day of the Athletes practice. Please notify the school if you are unable to obtain a physical. Parents must fill out a waiver form for any athlete participating in sports. Students will not able to participate in any level of athletic activity without a physical and all required participation forms.
6. Students are required to attend all games and practices unless excused by the coach. **Students may not play or practice if not in attendance at school on the day of the scheduled activity.**
7. A \$50 dollar fee per sport is required for student to participate payable to 21st Century Public Academy. (cash, check, or money order)
8. Parents are responsible for getting students to and from both games and practices that are not on campus.
9. Parent and student behavior will always be representative of the values of the school.
