The National Center for Education Statistics (NCES) at the U.S. Department of Education released the results of New Mexico's 2019 NAEP scores. Also known as the Nation's Report Card, NAEP measures what children in 4th and 8th grades know and can do in mathematics and reading across all states and jurisdictions, every two years. Approximately 11,000 of New Mexico's 4th and 8th graders participated in the 2019 NAEP assessment.

NAEP 2019 proficiency results were not significantly different from results in 2017. Specifically, 2019 results show that:

- 24 percent of 8th graders scored proficient or above in reading
- 21 percent of 8th graders scored proficient or above in math
