

Principal's Report

1. Procurement & IT

- a. Our school is now outfitted with fiber internet, substantially increasing our bandwidth. This has been especially beneficial during testing when we have all of our students online at the same time.

2. Training

- a. All staff have completed the required Child Sexual Abuse Prevention training.
- b. We have submitted our HB43 plans to the state, and are still awaiting information regarding the required diversity training.

3. Testing

- a. We have completed our mid-year short cycle assessment in NWEA MAPs.
- b. We have been selected again as one of the schools to administer the National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP). Our 8th graders will take this assessment on February 24th.
- c. We have entered the ordering window for ACCESS for ELLs as well as the NM-ASR and NM-MSSA assessments. The ELL assessment will take place in late January, while the Science, Math, and ELA assessments will take place in April.
- d. Ms. Elliott and I are attending the virtual DTC training series which began December 15th.

4. Staffing

- a. We have hired two new EAs to fill out our staff, so that we have a dedicated EA and SPED teacher for each of the middle school grades.

5. Events

- a. January 3rd In-Service
 - i. Staff will review midyear testing data and adjust schedules/curriculum maps accordingly.
 - ii. Staff will also participate in QPR training led by our social worker. This is an emergency response training for responding to young people in crisis as a suicide prevention measure.
