Academic/Social Athletic Standards

- 1. Students must maintain the equivalent of a 2.0 average with no failing grades for academic eligibility. If a student with a 2.0 grade point average receives two D's or one F on a grade check or report card, he/she shall be placed on a two-week probationary period to increase grades. During this time the athlete may practice with his/her team, but may not participate in games or competitions. Once the grade point average is actable or after the two-week probationary period, the athlete must submit a new grade check to the Athletic Director for eligibility.
- 2. If a student-athlete with a 2.0 grade receives an **unsatisfactory mark in conduct for any reason**, he/she may be placed on a 1-week probationary period to bring the mark back up.
- 3. Student-athletes must provide a grade check form to each teacher every two weeks or on a specific date approved by the school's Director of Athletics. The grade check form must be signed by a parent/guardian and should be returned to the Athletic Director on or by the assigned due day. Failing to submit the form within the specified time could result in a reduction of participation time for the athlete.
- 4. Student-athletes must maintain an acceptable level of discipline in the school environment and on the athletic field. Failure to meet any school standards could result in a reduction of participation time for the athlete.
- 5. Medical permission (proof of physical) must be valid and on file with the 21st Athletic Department to participate in competition/tournaments. Please notify the school if you are unable to obtain a physical. Parents must fill out a waiver form for the student-athlete prior to participating in sports. Students will not be able to participate in any level of athletic activity/competition without a physical and all required participation forms.
- 6. Student-athletes are required to attend all games and practices unless excused by the coach. Student-athletes may not play or practice if absent (unexcused) from school on the day of the scheduled activity.
- 7. A \$100 dollar fee **per sport** is required for the student to participate payable to 21st Century Public Academy due on the first day of the program's practice.
- 8. Parents are responsible for getting student-athletes to and from practices and games that are not on campus.

Note: Coaches will not be responsible for arranging or transporting athletes to athletic events.

- 9. Student-athletes will be required to participate in a minimum of one (1) designated fundraiser to aid in raising money for the 21st CPA Athletic Sports Program.
- 10. Parent and student-athlete behavior will always be representative of the values of the school.
