1. Technology

- a. Student chromebooks have been updated with all the necessary state testing applications for this school year.

2. OSIs

- a. Mission Specific Goal: *75% of students, enrolled on the 40th and 120th day, will complete at least 18 OSIs and earn a minimum of a 3 on the RACED writing OSI Assignment Rubric on the final assignment for the year.*

3. Testing

- a. We were informed by PED that we have been selected to participate in the National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP) this school year. Often referred to as the "Nation's Report Card" this is an assessment that is given to 4th and 8th graders at randomly selected schools in each state. We do not receive the individual school's results from this assessment. Only about half of our 8th graders will have to take this test, and the window is in February. When I have a specific date for the assessment I will inform the GC.

4. School Advisory Committee

- a. The SAC met last week to discuss new membership needs as well as goals for the current school year. It was proposed that a questionnaire be created and
