Academic/Social Athletic Standards

- 1. Student-athletes must maintain passing grades (60% or higher) with no failing grades for academic eligibility. If a student receives two D's or one F on a grade check or report card, he/she shall be placed on a one-week probationary period to improve grades. During this time the Athletic Department will determine if the athlete may practice with his/her team, or participate in games or competitions. Once the grades, and grade point average are actable or after the one-week probationary period, the athlete must submit a new grade check to the Athletic Director for eligibility.
- 2. The Athletic Director will check or review Athletes' grades once every two weeks with their designated teachers. This will be done to ensure the athlete's academic grades are presented as eligible to participate.
- 3. If a student-athlete receives an unsatisfactory mark in conduct for any reason, he/she may be placed on a probationary period to bring the mark back up.
- 4. Student-athletes must maintain an acceptable level of discipline in the school environment and on the athletic field. Failure to meet any school standards could result in a reduction of participation time such as practice or competition for the athlete.
- Medical permission (proof of physical) must be valid and on file with the 21st Athletic Department to
 participate in competitions/tournaments. Please notify the school if you are unable to obtain a physical.
 Parents must fill out a school waiver form for the student-athlete prior to participating in sports
 practices. Students will not be able to participate in any level of athletic activity/competition
 without a physical and all required participation forms.
- Student-athletes are required to attend all games and practices unless excused by the coach.
 Student-athletes may not play or practice if absent from school on the day of the scheduled activity.
- 6. A \$100 dollar fee **per sport** is required for the student to participate, payable to 21st Century Public Academy, due on the first day of the program's practice.
- 7. Parents are responsible for getting student-athletes to and from practices and games that are not on campus.

Note: Coaches will not be responsible for arranging or transporting student-athletes to any athletic events.

- 8. Student-athletes are asked to participate in at least one designated sports fundraiser to support fundraising efforts for the 21st CPA Athletic Sports Program.
- 9. Parent and student-athlete behavior will always be representative of the values of the school and participating league.
