

## Principal's Report

### 1. Technology

- a. The necessary part to repair our intercom system (outdoors, hallways, and gym speakers) has been installed, and is operational. It has been revealed since this install that there are two speakers not functioning in the Phase 2 hallways. Harmonix is aware of the issue and seeking repair.
- b. We have started the process of changing out the chromebooks in the 1st and 2nd grade classrooms with iPads, which should work better for our youngest students' technology needs. The 1st grade classroom has already been outfitted with these iPads, and the 2nd grade classroom will follow in the coming weeks.

### 2. OSIs

- a. Mission Specific Goal: *75% of students, enrolled on the 40th and 120th day, will complete at least 18 OSIs and earn a minimum of a 3 on the RACED writing OSI Assignment Rubric on the final assignment for the year.*
  - i. New language for 2025-2026:  
*"75% of students, enrolled on the 40th and 120th day, will complete at least 16 OSIs if in grades 6-8 or at least 10 OSIs if in grades 1-5, and will earn a minimum average of a 3 on the RACED writing OSI Assignment Rubric on the final half of OSIs for the year."*
