

## Principal's Report

### 1. Technology

- a. Our MS Science Department Chair made contact with a representative from NM Agriculture in the Classroom, who has offered to give our staff training on applying hydroponics in the classroom, at no cost to the school. We will be conducting this training at our January 5th In-Service, and all teachers will receive a classroom kit afterward.

### 2. OSIs
