

Principal's Report

1. Technology

- a. The school is now set up with MySchoolBucks, which allows us to take online payments as well as credit card payments at the school. It is synced with ParentVUE, so parents can see all the fees they owe for anything school related, and also pay via the same place they can check their students' grades and attendance.
- b. We have subscribed with GoGuardian, which has three main features:
 - i. Web Filtering - Blocks inappropriate sites without us having to manually add sites to a blocklist as students discover them. It is constantly maintained by GoGuardian staff to find new sites that should be blocked.
 - ii. Teacher Monitoring - Allows teachers to view from their teacher computer what all students are looking at on their chromebooks/ipads. Also allows the teacher to take control of any or all student machines to direct them to where they want them to go.
 - iii. Hall Pass - Creates a digital hall pass system that allows us to know which students are out of the classroom at any given moment, what their destination was, and allows us to block certain students from being out of the classroom at the same time. This will give us the ability to prevent students planning to meet up in the bathroom, for example.

2. OSIs

- a. Mission Specific Goal: 75% of students, enrolled on the 40th and 120th day, will complete at least 16 OSIs if in grades 6-8 or at least 10 OSIs if in grades 1-5, and will earn a minimum average of a 3 on the RACED writing OSI Assignment Rubric on the final half of OSIs for the year.

3. Testing

- a. The state's school accountability system lifted its embargo on school ranking data last week. We have earned a "Traditional" rating in NM Vistas. I will present an analysis of this ranking and what it means for our school at the next GC meeting.

4. School Advisory Committee

- a. We still need to re-form the School Advisory Committee (SAC). GC bylaws state that the SAC consists of 1-2 GC members, and equal staff and parental membership. The bylaw language regarding the SAC's purpose is as follows:
 - i. *"The purpose of the SAC will be to assist the school principal with school-based decision-making and to involve parents in their children's education. The committee shall:*
 1. *work with the school principal and give advice, consistent with state and school district rules and policies, on policies relating to instructional issues and curricula on the publi school's proposed and actual budgets.*
 2. *develop creative ways to involve parents in the school.*
 3. *where appropriate, coordinate with any existing work force development boards or vocational education advisory councils to connect students and school academic programs to business resources and opportunities; and*
 4. *serve as the champion for students in building community support for schools and encouraging greater community participation in the public schools."*
