

## Educational Foundations/Organizations

The Governance Council understands and recognizes the importance of community support of school programs and activities, including voluntary financial contributions to assist the school in realizing its goals. The Governing Council desires to work cooperatively with 21<sup>st</sup> Century Public Academy Foundation, the Cutler Charitable Foundation and the 21<sup>st</sup> Century PTA to determine the purposes for which funds may be used to assist in reaching school goals. While state and federal funds provide for the operational expenses of the school, the supporting organizations can assist with securing funds for enhanced needs both academic and facility based programming.

### Procedures:

1. No current member of the Governance Council shall serve as a voting member of the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Public Academy Foundation, the Cutler Charitable Foundation or serve as an officer of the 21<sup>st</sup> Century PTA.
2. The supporting organizations may use the school name, mascot or any logo for events and advertising.
3. The Governance Board Finance Committee will review the supporting organizations Fiscal Policies and Procedures on an annual basis. The PTA can submit policies from the State Organization and is subject to oversight by this organization.
4. The Governance Council Vice President, or designee, will attend quarterly meetings of the supporting organizations. A representative from the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Public Academy Foundation and the Cutler Charitable Foundation will attend quarterly Governance Council Finance meetings to present and receive quarterly statements.
5. The Governance Council and the supporting organizations shall work together to resolve any audit issues that may arise.
